## **BIKE LICENCE**



Dear Parents/Carers

The Narwee Public School Bike Licence is a way of ensuring our students are being safe and following the NSW government laws.

- It is compulsory to wear a correctly fitted approved helmet when riding a bike in NSW.
- This applies to all bicycle riders regardless of age, including children on bicycles with training wheel and any child being carried as a passenger on a bike or in a trailer.

The following guidelines must be adhered to:

- 1. All students who ride a bike or scooter to school will need to obtain a Bike Licence which is an agreement that they will wear a <u>helmet</u> when riding.
- 2. A Bike Licence will be issued and attached to your child's bike or scooter as an indication that they have permission to ride to school.
- 3. Students are able to enter through either set of school gates but must dismount their bike or scooter once they are on school grounds and immediately walk their bike to the bike rack.
- 4. They must park their bike or scooter in the designated bike rack, outside the Library.
- 5. At the end of day, all bikes must be walked out of the school and ridden safely along the footpath.
- 6. Students must be mindful of pedestrians when riding along the path.

Please ensure your child is following these guidelines and is wearing their helmet **EVERY** day when riding to school.

If your child rides to school please complete the slip below signed by both yourself and your child and return it to your child's class teacher.
