As you know, we are moving into new phases of learning for this term.

Weeks 1 and 2 will have online or paper-based learning continuing, much like last term. This is Phase 0.

From Week 3 beginning on Monday 11 May, we will move to Phase 1.

This means your child can come to school for lessons **1 day per week.** This is about 25% of our students each day. Students will be in one of 7 small year groups with a teacher from their stage.
