I wish to thank all of our Year 5 students who presented leadership speeches to fellow Primary students last week. Sixteen students presented their speeches to their peers which is never an easy task. The voting process was online this year as we make use of Google form surveys. The incoming 2021 captains, vice-captains and prefects will be announced at Presentation Day on Wednesday 9 December.

As we are unable to have parents and families attending our Presentation Day assemblies due to current restrictions, we will have a live stream production on the day. Watch out for the link which will be posted in our next and final newsletter in Week 8. The Stage 3 production will be from 9.40, the K-2 production will begin at 11.10 and Stage 2 will begin at 12.50. It is estimated that each assembly will be approximately 1 hour. You will be able to view the live stream from your phone or computer device.

We have reviewed our students' progress from Term 1 to Term 4 in Vocabulary, Grammar, Reading and Numeracy. The results show that your children have made very good progress across the year with many students showing significant growth with regular school attendance supporting these improvements.

A big thank you to all our students who are sun-safe and wearing their school hat. I am very proud to see the majority of students doing so, along with wearing their full school uniform. It demonstrates the pride and care that our students take each and every day.

Annual Swimming Carnival

Tuesday 2 February 2021

Our annual Swimming Carnival will be held on Tuesday 2 February 2021 from 10.00am to 3.00pm at Peakhurst West Public School. This will be in Term 1, Week 2, 2021.

All children in Years 3, 4, 5, 6 and Year 2 children turning 8 in 2021 are expected to attend. As this is an authorised school activity, all teachers will be attending the carnival.

Activities will be provided to enable all children, both swimmers and non-swimmers to participate. 100m, 50m and 25m races will be held in the 2 metre deep pool and novelty events will be held in the 1 metre deep end of the pool or the wading pool. Those students who participate in deep water races also participate in the novelty events. House points will be given to all children who take part in the novelty and competition events. Please indicate your child's swimming ability in the appropriate section on the permission slip.

Travel to and from the pool will be by bus leaving school at 9.30am and returning by 3.20pm. Children attending must be at school no later than 9.15am. Due to time restrictions we are unable to wait for late arrivals.

The cost is \$8.00. This covers bus fare and pool hire charges. No refunds will be given if your child is absent on the day as these costs need to be paid in advance and are not refundable to the school.

Due to the carnival being held early in the year we ask that money and permission notes be returned by Friday 27 November 2020 (Week 7).

Children can wear their house colours or sports uniform with accessories in their house colours. They must ensure that they have a hat, swimmers and a towel.

Children must bring their lunch, recess and drinks for the day as there is no canteen for students.

Parking Near the School

When dropping off or picking up your child please ensure you park in the appropriate streets surrounding the school. Take note to comply with the 'No Stopping' or 'Bus Zones' along Broad Arrow Rd.

There is a 'Kiss and Drop' zone opposite the school. In this area drivers may stop to drop off or pick up children however, 'No Parking' rules apply.

- Maximum stop time is 2 minutes
- Driver must remain in or within 3 metres of their vehicle
- Vehicles must not be left unattended

The police and rangers patrol around the school regularly. Fines can be quite expensive for parking illegally around a school.

Please be mindful of our neighbours when dropping off or picking up your children by not blocking or parking across driveways particularly around the Esme Lane Parade area.

Important Canteen News

Just a reminder that the canteen does not provide credit to student. Please ensure your child has money with them each time they wish to purchase from the canteen. This includes money for their lunch orders.
